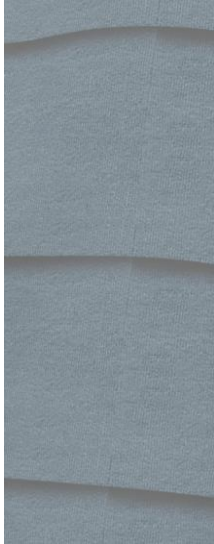


UTILIZING PATTERN PREVIEW - PHOTOSHOP

Pattern Preview in Photoshop is a viewing tool that allows the user to view what their repeat looks like tiled, before bringing their texture into a 3D program.

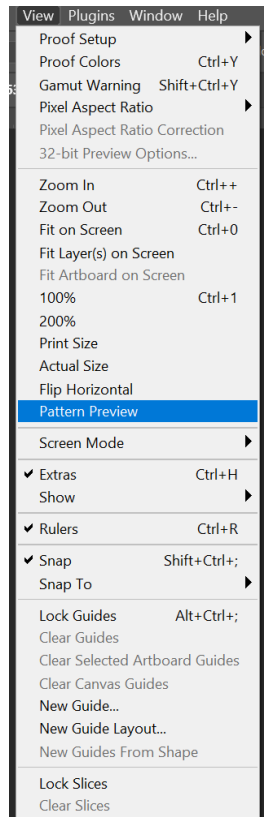


Repeat Texture with undesired shadow tiling

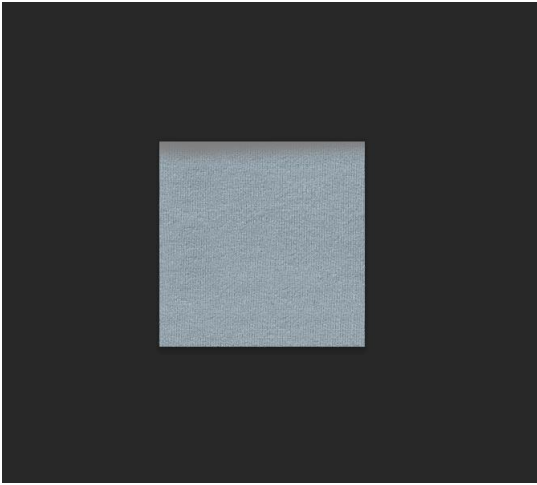


Repeat Texture after Photoshop cleanup

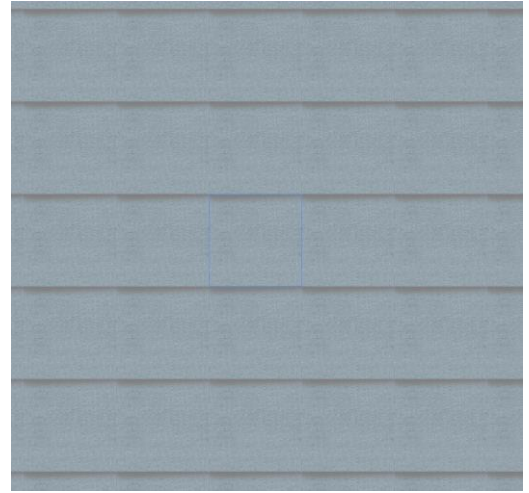
- ▶ **Select: View** from the top tool bar. Then within the Dropdown Menu, **Select: Pattern Preview**



- ▶ The single texture artboard will now multiply by 1x1 tiling. The Section with the Blue Box is the original image:

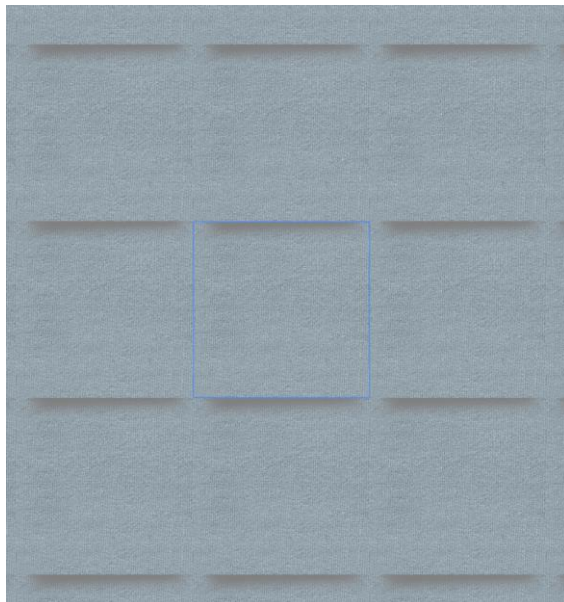


Our single repeat texture in Photoshop

- ▶ Now you can start to edit any section of the Pattern Preview, as if it was one large image. We utilize the  Spot Healing and the  Clone Stamp tools to create our seamless texture repeats.



- ▶ Every section of the repeat would be updated at the same time. This is an easy way to view how seamless your current texture repeat is!
